

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of these Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations extend the currency of Ulster Savings Certificates of the Tenth Issue for a further six years, i.e. from six years to twelve years, with interest at the rate of one shilling per year for each unit certificate and an additional one shilling per unit certificate at the end of the twelfth year.

SUMMARY JURISDICTION

Petty Sessions Districts and Times

ORDER, DATED 30TH APRIL 1969, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 21(3)(f) OF THE MAGISTRATES' COURTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1964.

The Ministry of Home Affairs in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 21(3)(f) of the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, after consultation with the County Court Judges and Resident Magistrates concerned, hereby orders and directs as follows:—

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Petty Sessions Districts and Times (Crumlin) Order (Northern Ireland) 1969 and shall come into operation on the 12th day of May 1969.

Place for Holding Crumlin Petty Sessions

2. Petty Sessions for the Petty Sessions District of Crumlin shall be held at Antrim, a place outside the Petty Sessions District of Crumlin, but not more than six miles from the boundary of the said District and at the times specified in the Petty Sessions Districts and Times (General) Order (Northern Ireland) 1967(b).
