ORDER, DATED 28TH NOVEMBER 1969, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE CONSTABULARY AND POLICE (IRELAND) ACT 1919, SECTION 2 OF THE CONSTABULARY ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1922 AND THE CONSTABULARY (PENSIONS) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1949.

I, the Right Honourable Robert Wilson Porter, Q.C., Minister of Home Affairs, with the concurrence of the Ministry of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 4 of the Constabulary and Police (Ireland) Act 1919(a), Section 2 of the Constabulary Act (Northern Ireland) 1922(b), the Constabulary (Pensions) Act (Northern Ireland) 1949(c) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf and after considering representation made by the Representative Bodies constituted by the said Act of 1919 as required by Section 4 of that Act, do hereby order as follows:—

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions (Amending) (No. 3) Order 1969, shall be construed as one with the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions Orders 1949 to 1969, and shall be included in the Orders which may be cited together as the said Orders, and shall have effect as from 3rd November 1969.

Amendment of the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions Order 1949

2. The Schedule to the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions Order 1949(d), as amended(e), shall be further amended as follows:—

- (1) In paragraph 12(3) for the amount "127s. Od." there shall be substituted the amount "140s. Od.", and for the amount "90s. Od." there shall be substituted the amount "100s. Od."
- (2) In paragraph 13B(4) for the amount "127s. Od." there shall be substituted the amount "140s. Od.", and for the amount "90s. Od." there shall be substituted the amount "100s. Od."
- (3) In the proviso to paragraph 17(6) for the amount "90s. Od." there shall be substituted the amount "100s. Od."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order amends the provisions of the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions Order 1949 relating to the discretionary increases in widows' pensions. Article 2(1), (2) and (3) increases the amount by which widows' pensions may be increased in those cases in which discretionary increases are permitted.
