## NEW TOWNS AND TOWN DEVELOPMENT

## Designation Order

ORDER\*, DATED 5TH FEBRUARY 1969, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF DEVELOPMENT, WITH THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MINISTER OF FINANCE, UNDER SECTIONS 1 AND 47 OF THE NEW TOWNS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1965.

I, the Right Honourable Ivan Neill, Minister of Development, with the concurrence of the Minister of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sections 1 and 47 of the New Towns Act (Northern Ireland) 1965(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), hereby make the following Order:—

*Citation*

1. This Order may be cited as the Londonderry Area Designation Order (Northern Ireland) 1969.

*Designation of Area*

2. The area of land comprising the County Borough of Londonderry and the Rural District of Londonderry and shown surrounded by a thick black line on the map marked "Londonderry Area Designation Order (Northern Ireland) 1969, Map" and signed by me is hereby designated as an area to be developed in accordance with the provisions of the Act.
