MOTOR VEHICLES: THIRD PARTY INSURANCE

REGULATIONS, DATED 29TH AUGUST 1969, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 13 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1930 AND SECTION 72 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1955.

The Ministry of Home Affairs in exercise of the powers vested in it by Section 13 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1930(a) and Section 72 of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1955(b), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Risks) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1969 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1969.

Regulations amended

2. The Motor Cars (Third Party Risks) (Northern Ireland) Regulations 1934(c) shall have effect as though at the end of Regulation 8(b) there were added the following proviso—

“Provided that where a deposit is intended to cover the use of more than 10 motor vehicles at one time then the Certificate of Deposit may be in such other form as the Ministry of Home Affairs may determine”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations further amend the Motor Cars (Third Party Risks) (Northern Ireland) Regulations 1934 by enabling the Ministry to authorise a Form of Deposit covering more than ten vehicles.
