ROAD VEHICLES

REGULATIONS, DATED 15TH OCTOBER 1969, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1929.

The Ministry of Home Affairs, in exercise of the powers vested in it by Section 8 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1929(a) and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Vehicles (School Crossings) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1969.

Regulations Amended

2. The Road Vehicles (School Crossings) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1968(b) shall have effect as though in Regulation 5(2) the word "constant" were deleted.

These Regulations amend the Road Vehicles (School Crossings) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1968 to allow for a flashing light on the patrol sign.
