**HEALTH SERVICES (AMENDMENT) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND)
1969****Appointed Day**

ORDER, DATED 23RD DECEMBER 1969, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES UNDER SECTION 50 OF THE HEALTH SERVICES (AMENDMENT) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1969.

I, the Right Honourable William Kennedy Fitzsimmons, Minister of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 50 of the Health Services (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland) 1969(a), do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Health Services (Amendment) Act (Appointed Day) Order (Northern Ireland) 1969.

2. The Health Services (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland) 1969 shall, except as in the Act or hereinafter otherwise provided, come into operation on the 1st January 1970.

3. Sections 8 and 9 and so much of the consequential amendments and repeals in Schedules 1 and 3 relating to the said sections 8 and 9 shall come into operation on the 31st March 1970.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Section 50 of the Health Services (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland) 1969 came into operation on the passing of this Act. This Order brings into operation from 1st January 1970 the remaining provisions of the Act other than those of sections 8 and 9 which come into operation on 31st March 1970.
