Grants and Loans to Industrial Training Boards

Order*, dated 6th November 1969, made by the Ministry of Health and Social Services with the consent of the Ministry of Finance under section 5(3) of the Industrial Training Act (Northern Ireland) 1964.

The Ministry of Health and Social Services with the consent of the Ministry of Finance in exercise of powers conferred by section 5(3) of the Industrial Training Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Grants and Loans to Industrial Training Boards Order (Northern Ireland) 1969.

Grants and Loans out of moneys provided by Parliament

2. The aggregate of the grants and loans made to Industrial Training Boards under section 5 of the Act shall not exceed five million pounds.
