Reduction of Rates on Dwelling-houses

REGULATIONS*, DATED 14TH JANUARY 1969, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF DEVELOPMENT UNDER SECTION 1 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT (FINANCE) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1967.

The Ministry of Development in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 1 of the Local Government (Finance) Act (Northern Ireland) 1967(a) hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Reduction of Rates on Dwellinghouses Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1969.

Reduction of Domestic Rates

2. The amount in the pound by which the rates levied by rating authorities on dwelling-houses are to be reduced for the financial year commencing 1st April 1969 shall be three shillings and eleven pence.
