REGULATIONS, DATED 1ST APRIL 1969, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 15 OF THE FISHERIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1966.

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 15 of the Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Eel Fishing (Licence Duties Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1969.
- 2. There shall be payable to the Fisheries Conservancy Board for Northern Ireland by way of licence duties in respect of licences for the use of the fishing engines referred to in Column 1 of the Schedule for the taking of eels, the amounts respectively specified in Column 2 of the Schedule.
- 3. Part I and the Schedule to the Eel Fishing (Licence Duty and Limitations on Fishing) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1967(b) are hereby revoked.
