Grammar Schools (Admissions, Scholarships and Special Allowances)

REGULATIONS, DATED 20TH MAY 1970, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1947 TO 1968.

The Ministry of Education, in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 48 and 76 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland) 1947(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Grammar Schools (Admissions, Scholarships and Special Allowances) Amending Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970.

(2) These Regulations shall have effect from 1st August 1970.

2. The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Grammar Schools (Admissions, Scholarships and Special Allowances) Regulations 1965(b).

3. The following proviso shall be added to Regulation 7 of the existing Regulations:—

“Provided that where the authority is satisfied that a pupil’s parents are not ordinarily resident in its area and that the pupil is resident in the area solely or mainly for the purpose of receiving education the making of an award shall be at the discretion of the authority.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations provide for the making of an award to a qualified pupil in attendance at a grammar school to be at the discretion of the local education authority where it is satisfied that the pupil’s parents do not reside in its area and the pupil is resident in the area solely or mainly for the purpose of receiving education.

DISEASES OF ANIMALS

Poultry

ORDER, DATED 19TH MAY 1970, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTIONS 13 AND 53 OF THE DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1958.

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 13 and 53 of the Diseases of Animals Act (Northern Ireland) 1958(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order which may be cited as the Diseases of Animals (Restriction on Exhibition of Poultry) Order (Northern Ireland) 1970 shall come into operation on the 19th May 1970.

Interpretation

2. In this Order:—

“poultry” includes eggs of poultry.

Prohibition on Exhibition of Poultry

3. No exhibition of poultry shall be organised or held by any person, show society or association of poultry breeders or fanciers.

Saving

4. Notwithstanding Article 3 the Ministry may grant a licence allowing such exhibition subject to such conditions as may be specified in the licence.
