DISEASES OF ANIMALS**Warble Fly**

ORDER, DATED 28TH DAY OF MAY 1970, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTIONS 18 AND 53 OF THE DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1958.

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 18 and 53 of the Diseases of Animals Act (Northern Ireland) 1958(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order which may be cited as the Warble Fly (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1970 shall come into operation on 15th June 1970 and shall be read as one with the Warble Fly Order (Northern Ireland) 1969(b) (hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Order").

Amendment of Principal Order

2. For Article 5 of the Principal Order there shall be substituted the following Article:—

"5. No animal bearing visible evidence of disease shall be imported from the Republic of Ireland."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order amends the Warble Fly Order (Northern Ireland) 1969 by prohibiting the importation from the Republic of Ireland of cattle bearing visible evidence of the disease.
