Classification

REGULATIONS, DATED 26TH JUNE 1970, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, UNDER THE NATIONAL INSURANCE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1966.

The Ministry of Health and Social Services, in conjunction with the Ministry of Finance, in exercise of powers conferred by section 1(3) of the National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations, which may be cited as the National Insurance (Classification) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970, shall be read as one with the National Insurance (Classification) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1948(b) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations") and shall come into operation on 1st July 1970.

Amendment of the principal regulations

- 2. In Part III of Schedule 1(c) to the principal regulations (which Part sets out in column (A) employments in respect of which persons are treated as non-employed persons and their employment therein disregarded and in column (B) the persons excepted from the operation of column (A)), for paragraph 57 of column (A) (employment in the Ulster Special Constabulary) there shall be substituted the following paragraph:
 - "57. Employment in the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve.".
