FISHERIES**Rainbow Trout Waters**

BYE-LAWS, DATED 19TH JANUARY 1970, MADE BY THE FISHERIES CONSERVANCY BOARD FOR NORTHERN IRELAND WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 26 OF THE FISHERIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1966.

The Fisheries Conservancy Board for Northern Ireland in exercise of its powers under Section 26 of the Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Ministry of Agriculture, hereby makes the following Bye-laws:

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Rainbow Trout Waters Bye-laws (Northern Ireland) 1970.

2. These Bye-laws shall come into effect on 6th February 1970.

3. The under-named waters are hereby designated as Rainbow Trout Waters and there shall be no close season for angling for Rainbow Trout thereon:

Lough Coole, Co. Fermanagh.
Screeby Lake, Co. Tyrone.
Brantry Lake, Co. Tyrone.
Roughan Lake, Co. Tyrone.
Tullynawood Lake, Co. Armagh.
Darkley Lake, Co. Armagh.
Kernan Lake, Co. Armagh.
Castledillon Lake, Co. Armagh.
Gentle Owens, Co. Armagh.
Mossley Mill Pond, Co. Antrim.
Ballymartin Lough, Co. Down.
Ballymacashon Lough, Co. Down.
Tonaghmore Reservoir, Co. Down.
Henderson's Lake, Co. Londonderry.
Holybank Bleachworks Dam, Belfast

4. The Rainbow Trout Waters Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 1969(b) are hereby revoked.
