## Payments of Bonuses for Carcase Quality

Scheme, dated 3rd July 1970, made by the Minister of Agriculture for Northern Ireland under Section 1(1) of the Agriculture (Temporary Assistance) Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(a), as amended by the Agriculture (Temporary Assistance) (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland) 1957(b).

The Minister of Agriculture with the approval of the Minister of Finance and in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by the Agriculture (Temporary Assistance) Acts (Northern Ireland) 1954 and 1957 and of all other powers him thereunto enabling, hereby makes the following Scheme:—

### Short Title and Commencement

- 1. This Scheme may be cited as the Carcase Quality Bonus (Amendment No. 2) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1970 and shall come into operation on 10th July 1970.
- 2. The Carcase Quality Bonus (Amendment) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1970 shall be amended as follows:—

by substituting for the First Schedule thereto the Schedule to this Order.

# **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Scheme, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Scheme amends the First Schedule to the Carcase Quality Bonus (Amendment) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1970. The Amendment reduces the minimum cold carcase weights of animals which are young lightweights under the Fatstock Guarantee Scheme from 430 lb. to 410 lb. in the case of a steer and from 365 lb. to 345 lb. in the case of a heifer.
