The Ministry of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 4, 7 and 68 of the Food and Drugs Act (Northern Ireland) 1958(a), having consulted with such organisations as appear to it to be representative of interests substantially affected by these regulations, hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Emulsifiers and Stabilisers in Food (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1970.

Amendment of the principal regulations

2. The Emulsifiers and Stabilisers in Food Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1962(h) shall be amended by deleting from the First Schedule the words "Brominated edible vegetable oils."

Amendment of the principal regulations

2. The Colouring Matter in Food Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966(b) shall be amended by deleting from Part I of Schedule 1 the entry "Ponceau MX" in column 1 of that part and the entries relating thereto in columns 2, 3 and 4.
