Single Wall Set Nets or Trammel Nets

Bye-laws, dated 26th day of October 1970, made by the Fisheries. CONSERVANCY BOARD FOR NORTHERN IRELAND WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 26 OF THE FISHERIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1966.

The Fisheries Conservancy Board for Northern Ireland in exercise of its powers under Section 26 of the Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Ministry of Agriculture hereby makes the following Bye-laws:

- 1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Float Size Bye-laws (Northern Ireland) 1970.
- 2. For Bye-law 28 of the Fisheries Consolidated Amendment and Licence Duties Bye-laws (Northern Ireland) 1969(b) there shall be substituted the following Bye-law:
 - "28. Each net or row of nets of a single wall set net or trammel net used for the taking of trout in Lough Neagh and each net or row of nets of a single wall set net or trammel net used for the taking of freshwater fish other than trout and rainbow trout, on any water shall be marked at each end with a float of a bright yellow colour projecting not less than twelve inches above the water and not less than twelve inches across."
 - 3. These Bye-laws shall come into effect on 14th December 1970.
- 4. The Coarse Fishing Set Net Bye-laws (Northern Ireland) 1970(c) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
