FIRE SERVICES**Grants to Northern Ireland Fire Authority**

REGULATIONS*, DATED 25TH NOVEMBER 1970, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 22(5) OF THE FIRE SERVICES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1969.

The Ministry of Home Affairs in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 22(5) of the Fire Services Act (Northern Ireland) 1969(a) and with the consent of the Ministry of Finance hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and effect

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fire Services (Grants to Northern Ireland Fire Authority) (No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970 and shall have effect in respect of the financial year ending 31st March 1971 and each subsequent financial year.

Amount of grants

2. In Section 22(1) of the Fire Services Act (Northern Ireland) 1969 for the references to "one hundred and seven thousand pounds" there shall be substituted references to "one hundred and nineteen thousand pounds" and for the references to "three hundred and ten thousand pounds" there shall be substituted references to "three hundred and forty-six thousand pounds".

3. The Fire Services (Grants to Northern Ireland Fire Authority) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970(b) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

The purpose of these Regulations is to increase the limits on which the Ministry pay a 50% grant to the Northern Ireland Fire Authority. The limit for loan charges has been increased by £12,000 and the limit for other net expenditure by £36,000.
