**FISHERIES****Angling Licence Duties**

BYE-LAWS, DATED 19TH FEBRUARY 1970, MADE BY THE FISHERIES CONSERVANCY BOARD FOR NORTHERN IRELAND WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE, UNDER SECTION 26 OF THE FISHERIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1966.

The Fisheries Conservancy Board for Northern Ireland in exercise of its powers under Section 26 of the Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, with the approval of the Ministry of Agriculture, hereby makes the following Bye-laws:

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Angling Licence Duties Bye-laws (Northern Ireland) 1970.

2. There shall be substituted for Part I of Schedule I of the Fisheries Consolidated Amendment and Licence Duties Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 1969(b) the following provisions:

**"PART I****Licences to fish with rod and line and hand line**

Season game fishing rod licence . . . . .	2 5 0
Fifteen-day game fishing rod licence . . . . .	1 10 0
Additional amount payable by the holder of a Foyle Fisheries Commission salmon rod licence to use a single season game rod . . . . .	15 0
Season coarse fishing rod licence . . . . .	10 0
Fifteen-day coarse fishing rod licence . . . . .	5 0 "

3. These Bye-laws shall come into effect on 1st March 1970.
