#### BEE PESTS AND DISEASES

REGULATIONS, DATED 12TH MARCH 1970, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER THE BEE PEST PREVENTION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1945.

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 2 of the Bee Pest Prevention Act (Northern Ireland) 1945(a), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

## Citation and Commencement

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Bee Pest Prevention (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970.

(2) These Regulations and the Bee Pest Prevention Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1950 and 1961 may be cited together as the Bee Pest Prevention Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1950 to 1970.

(3) These Regulations shall come into operation on 1st April 1970.

#### Revocation

2. The fees payable under Regulation 10 of the Bee Pest Prevention Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1950(b) shall cease to be payable and accordingly the Bee Pest Prevention (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966(c) are hereby revoked.
