**SUMMARY JURISDICTION****Petty Sessions Districts and Times**

ORDER, DATED 18TH MARCH 1970, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 21(3)(f) OF THE MAGISTRATES' COURTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1964.

The Ministry of Home Affairs in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 21(3)(f) of the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, after consultation with the County Court Judge and Resident Magistrate concerned, hereby orders and directs as follows:—

*Citation and Commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Petty Sessions Districts and Times (Keady) Order (Northern Ireland) 1970 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of May 1970.

*Place for Holding Keady Petty Sessions*

2. Petty Sessions shall be held regularly for the Keady Petty Sessions District and shall be held at Armagh, a place outside the Petty Sessions District of Armagh but not more than six miles from the boundary of the said District at the times set out in the second column of the schedule to the Order made by the Ministry of Home Affairs on the 18th April 1967(b).
