ROAD TRAFFIC: "PELICAN" PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS

REGULATIONS, DATED 1ST JULY 1971, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 25 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1970.

The Ministry of Home Affairs in exercise of the powers vested in it by Section 25 of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the "Pelican" Pedestrian Crossings (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1971.

Regulations amended

2. Regulation 2 of the "Pelican" Pedestrian Crossings Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970(b) shall have effect as though for the date "10th July 1971" there were substituted the date "31st December 1971".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations change the date on which the Pedestrian Crossings ("Cross Ways") Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1967 will be revoked from the 10th July 1971, to the 31st December 1971.
