EXPORTED ANIMALS (AMENDMENT OF CHARGES) ORDER

ORDER, DATED 29TH JANUARY 1971, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE EXPORTED ANIMALS (COMPENSATION) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1952.

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 5 of the Exported Animals (Compensation) Act (Northern Ireland) 1952(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, following consultation with the Trustees appointed for the purposes of the Act, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order which may be cited as the Exported Animals (Amendment of Charges) Order (Northern Ireland) 1971 shall come into operation on 15th February 1971.

Scale of charges

2. For the sums payable as charges as specified under Section 5 of the Act in respect of animals delivered to a ship owner for export there shall be substituted the following:—

- (a) on every head of cattle the sum of 4p;
- (b) on every sheep the sum of 1p;
- (c) on every pig the sum of 1p.

This Order increases and expresses in decimal currency the charges payable by owners of exported animals to the Trustees of the Compensation Fund.
