REGULATIONS*, DATED 2ND FEBRUARY 1971, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES UNDER THE WELFARE FOODS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1968.

The Ministry of Health and Social Services in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 5(2) of Welfare Foods Act (Northern Ireland) 1968(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following regulations—

Title and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Welfare Foods (Extension of Definition) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1971 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1971.

Addition to definition of Welfare Food

2. In the definition of "Welfare Food" in section 5(1) of the Welfare Foods Act (Northern Ireland) 1968 there shall be added the following foods—

"Vitamins A, D and C combined in liquid form".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations extend the definition of Welfare Food in section 5(1) of the Welfare Foods Act (Northern Ireland) 1968 to include vitamins A, D and C combined in liquid form.
