DISEASES OF ANIMALS**Landing of Carcasses and Animal Products**

ORDER, DATED 27TH APRIL 1972, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTIONS 18 AND 53 OF THE DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1958.

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 18 and 53 of the Diseases of Animals Act (Northern Ireland) 1958(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order which may be cited as the Landing of Carcasses and Animal Products (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1972 shall come into operation on 27th April 1972 and shall be read as one with the Landing of Carcasses and Animal Products Order (Northern Ireland) 1970(b) (hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Order").

Amendment of the Principal Order

2. The Principal Order shall be amended as follows:—

(1) In Article 3 for the definition of "animal product" there shall be substituted the following definition—

"animal product" means meat meal, meat and bone meal, bone meal, bone flour, hoof and horn meal, blood meal and dried blood or any product containing any of the aforesaid products, also any other product derived from an animal including fat (whether rendered or otherwise processed), lard, meat extracts or oil (whether processed or unprocessed) so derived, also dairy products and rumen extracts.

(2) After Paragraph 7 of the First Schedule (which mentions carcasses and products to which licensing restrictions do not apply) the following paragraph shall be added—

"8. Butter, cheese, yoghurt, sterilised or evaporated milk and cream in tins."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order adds dairy products and rumen extracts to the definition of animal product for the purposes of the Landing of Carcases and Animal Products Order (Northern Ireland) 1970 and exempts certain dairy products from import licence requirements.
