Primary Schools (General)

REGULATIONS, DATED 14TH FEBRUARY 1972, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1947 TO 1971 WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

The Ministry of Education hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry", in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 84 and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland) 1947(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Primary Schools (General) Amending Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1972.
- 2. The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Primary Schools (General) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1961(b).
- 3. For Regulation 40 of the existing Regulations there shall be substituted the following:—
 - "40. A qualified teacher shall not be eligible for appointment to the posts of Principal, Vice-Principal, Second Master or Mistress or to a post attracting a salary under any of the Scales 2, 3, 4 or 5 of Schedule 2 to the Teachers' Salaries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1972(c) unless he has successfully completed his period of probation."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

In consequence of the introduction of new salary scales these Regulations amend those provisions of the existing Regulations which prescribe the conditions in which qualified teachers become eligible for senior posts, such as Principals, Vice-Principals and Second Masters and Mistresses.
