SUMMARY JURISDICTION**Petty Sessions Districts and Times**

ORDER, DATED 28TH NOVEMBER 1972, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 21(3) OF THE MAGISTRATES' COURTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1964.

The Ministry of Home Affairs, on behalf of the Secretary of State and in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 21(3)(d) of the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, after consultation with the County Court Judge and Resident Magistrate concerned, hereby orders and directs as follows:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Petty Sessions Districts and Times (No. 6) Order (Northern Ireland) 1972 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1973.

Abolition of Forkhill Petty Sessions District

2. The Petty Sessions District of Forkhill shall be added to and become part of the Petty Sessions District of Newtownhamilton and in consequence thereof the Petty Sessions District of Forkhill is hereby abolished.

Revocations

3. The Petty Sessions Districts and Times (General) Order (Northern Ireland) 1967(b) in so far as it relates to the times and sittings of the Forkhill Petty Sessions, and the Petty Sessions Districts and Times (Forkhill) Order (Northern Ireland) 1971(c) are hereby revoked.
