SUMMARY JURISDICTION

Petty Sessions Districts and Times

Order, dated 15th February 1972, made by the Ministry of Home Affairs under Section 21(3)(f) of the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964.

The Ministry of Home Affairs in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 21(3)(f) of the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, after consultation with the County Court Judges and Resident Magistrates concerned, hereby orders and directs as follows:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Petty Sessions Districts and Times (No. 1) Order (Northern Ireland) 1972 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of March 1972.

Places for holding Garvagh, Maghera and Moneymore Petty Sessions

2.—(1) Petty Sessions for the Petty Sessions District of Garvagh shall be held at Coleraine, a place outside the Petty Sessions District of Garvagh, but not more than six miles from the boundary of the said District and at the times specified in the Petty Sessions Districts and Times (General) Order (Northern Ireland) 1967(b).

(2) Petty Sessions for the Petty Sessions District of Maghera shall be held at Magherafelt, a place outside the Petty Sessions District of Maghera but not more than six miles from the boundary of the said District and at the times specified in the Petty Sessions Districts and Times (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1970(c).
