SUMMARY JURISDICTION

Petty Sessions Districts and Times

Order, dated 2nd March 1972, made by the Ministry of Home Affairs under Section 21(3) of the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964.

The Ministry of Home Affairs in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 21(3) of the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, after consultation with the County Court Judge and Resident Magistrates concerned, hereby orders and directs as follows:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Petty Sessions Districts and Times (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1972 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of April 1972.

Abolition of Ballygawley Petty Sessions District

2. The Petty Sessions District of Ballygawley shall be added to and become part of the Petty Sessions District of Aughnacloy, and in consequence thereof the Petty Sessions District of Ballygawley is hereby abolished.

Times of holding of Aughnacloy, Clogher and Dungannon Petty Sessions

3. Petty Sessions shall be held regularly for the Aughnacloy, Clogher and Dungannon Petty Sessions Districts at the times set out in the Schedule.

Revocation

4. The Petty Sessions Districts and Times (General) Order (Northern Ireland) 1967(b) insofar as it relates to the times and sittings of Aughnacloy, Ballygawley, Clogher and Dungannon Petty Sessions is hereby revoked.
