DISEASES OF ANIMALS**Warble Fly**

ORDER, DATED 8TH MARCH 1972, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTIONS 18 AND 53 OF THE DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1958.

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 18 and 53 of the Diseases of Animals Act (Northern Ireland) 1958(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order which may be cited as the Warble Fly (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1972 shall come into operation on 16th March 1972.

Amendment

2. Article 5 of the Warble Fly Order (Northern Ireland) 1969(b) as substituted by Article 3 of the Warble Fly (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1971(c) shall be amended as follows:—

After the words "signed by a Veterinary Surgeon" in Paragraph (3) there shall be added the words "or by a person authorised for the purpose by the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries in the Republic of Ireland".

This Order allows certificates of treatment for cattle imported from the Republic of Ireland to be signed by any officer who is authorised for the purpose by the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries in the Republic of Ireland.
