Teachers' Salaries (Compensation Allowances)

REGULATIONS, DATED 28TH MARCH 1972, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER THE EDUCATION ACIS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1947 TO 1971.

The Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 83 and 112 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland) 1947(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all powers enabling it in that behalf and after consultation with the Ministry of Finance hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Teachers' Salaries (Compensation Allowances) Amending Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1972.
- (2) These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st April 1971.
- 2. The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Teachers' Salaries (Compensation Allowances) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1972(b).
- 3. For paragraph (1) of Regulation 5 of the existing Regulations there shall be substituted the following:—
 - "5.—(1) In any case to which Regulation 3 or Regulation 4 applies a teacher who immediately before the date of reorganisation
 - (a) held a protected post as principal, vice-principal, or second master/mistress, or
 - (b) (i) held a protected post other than a post as under (a); and
 - (ii) held a protected post or posts throughout the whole of the qualifying period

and whose salary or allowance is reduced or ceases as a direct result of reorganisation will subject to paragraphs (3) and (4) be entitled to a compensation allowance determined in accordance with Regulation 6."
