Chief Electoral Officer (Salary) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973

Made31st March 1973Coming into operation12th April 1973To be laid before the Parliament of the United Kingdom
under paragraph 4(5)(b) of the Schedule to the Northern
Ireland (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 1(1) of the Northern Ireland (Temporary Provisions) Act $1972(\mathbf{a})$, section 14(6) of the Electoral Law Act (Northern Ireland) $1962(\mathbf{b})$ as inserted by Article 6 of the Electoral Law (Northern Ireland) Order $1972(\mathbf{c})$ and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf I hereby make the following Order.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Chief Electoral Officer (Salary) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973 and shall come into operation on 12th April 1973.

2. There shall, with effect from 16th August 1972, be paid to the Chief Electoral Officer for Northern Ireland, appointed under section 14(1) of the Electoral Law Act (Northern Ireland) 1962, a salary of £5,000 a year.
