Petty Sessions Districts and Times

ORDER, DATED 22ND JANUARY 1973, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 21(3)(f) OF THE MAGISTRATES' COURTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1964.

The Ministry of Home Affairs, on behalf of the Secretary of State and in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 21(3)(f) of the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, after consultation with the County Court Judge and Resident Magistrate concerned, hereby orders and directs as follows:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Petty Sessions Districts and Times (No. 1) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of March 1973.

Place for holding Kilrea Petty Sessions

2. Petty Sessions for the Petty Sessions District of Kilrea shall be held at Ballymoney, a place outside the Petty Sessions District of Kilrea, but not more than six miles from the boundary of the said District and at the times specified in the Petty Sessions Districts and Times (General) Order (Northern Ireland) 1972(b).

Appeals

3. Notwithstanding anything in section 144 of the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964, appeals to the County Court from the said Petty Sessions District of Kilrea shall continue to be heard at the sittings of the County Court for the Division of Coleraine in the County of Londonderry as if the said Petty Sessions for the Kilrea Petty Sessions District sat at Kilrea.
