Dundrod Circuit: Admission Charges

To be laid before the Parliament of the United Kingdom under paragraph 4(5)(b) of the Schedule to the Northern Ireland (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972.

The Ministry of Home Affairs, on behalf of the Secretary of State and in exercise of the powers vested in it by section 2(4) of the Road Races Act (Northern Ireland) 1950(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Dundrod Circuit (Admission Charges) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973 and shall come into operation on the 1st July 1973.

Charges

2.—(1) The maximum charge for a vehicle badge shall be:—

(a) for an omnibus \ldots \ldots \ldots \ldots \pounds 1

(b) for any other mechanically propelled vehicle 25p

(2) The maximum charge for a spectator badge shall be 50p.
