In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Article 1 of the Water and Sewerage Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1973(a) and by section 1(1) of the Northern Ireland (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972(b), I hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Water and Sewerage Services (Appointed Day) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973.
- 2. The appointed day for the purposes of Articles 10, 13, 36 and 57 of the Water and Sewerage Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1973 shall be 21st May 1973.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order brings into effect on 21st May 1973 the provisions in the Water and Sewerage Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1973 conferring powers on the Ministry of Development to take action in the event of water shortages, including power to acquire land and carry out works.
