SEEDS**Fees**

REGULATIONS, DATED 9TH JULY 1973, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 1(2A) OF THE SEEDS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1965.

The Ministry of Agriculture, on behalf of the Secretary of State and in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1(2A) of the Seeds Act (Northern Ireland) 1965(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Seeds (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973 and shall come into operation on 16th July 1973.

Fees

2. There shall be paid to the Ministry in respect of matters arising under regulations made under the Seeds Act (Northern Ireland) 1965, as amended by paragraph 1 of Schedule 3 to the European Communities (Agriculture) Order (Northern Ireland) 1972(b), being the matters specified in the first column of the Schedule to these Regulations, the fees specified in the second column of the said Schedule opposite the respective references to such matters.

SCHEDULE

Matters arising under the Vegetable Seeds Regulations 1973(c) in relation to the certification of basic seeds and certified seeds

<i>Matter</i>	<i>Fee</i>
Crop entry, that is to say, application for certification when a sample of the seeds to be used for the production of the crop is already in the possession of the certifying authority. In the case of such an application relating to a biennial species, no fee will be payable if the application is withdrawn before 1st November in the year of sowing.	£ 5.00
Stock entry, that is to say, application for certification when a sample of the seeds to be used for the production of the crop is not in the possession of the certifying authority.	10.00
Seed levy, that is to say, fee payable on the final weight of seeds that have undergone the certification process, being seeds of one of the following kinds:—	
Turnip	0.08 per cwt
Red Beet	0.60 per cwt
Cabbage	0.75 per cwt
Lettuce	2.00 per cwt
Brussels sprout	1.50 per cwt
Tomato	1.00 per lb
Cauliflower	0.08 per lb
Labelling	0.05 per label
Drawing of sample for the official examination mentioned in regulation 5(2) of the Vegetable Seeds Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973	4.75 per sample

EXPLANATORY NOTE
