Local Government (General Exchequer Grant) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973

Made 1st October 1973

Coming into operation . . . 31st October 1973

To be laid before the Parliament of the United Kingdom under paragraph 4(5)(b) of the Schedule to the Northern Ireland (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972.

The Ministry of Development on behalf of the Secretary of State and in exercise of the powers conferred on it by paragraph 3(1) of Part I of Schedule 1 to the Local Government &c. (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Government (General Exchequer Grant) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973 and shall come into operation on 31st October 1973.

General Exchequer Grant

2. For the purposes of paragraph 3(1) of Part I of Schedule 1 to the Local Government &c. (Northern Ireland) Order 1972 the districts specified for the period of six months ending on 31st March 1974 shall be all of the 26 districts in Northern Ireland.
