CORONERS—SALARIES, FEES AND EXPENSES

RULES, DATED 23RD FEBRUARY 1973, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 36 OF THE CORONERS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1959.

The Ministry of Home Affairs on behalf of the Secretary of State and in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 36(1)(a) of the Coroners Act (Northern Ireland) 1959(a), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and after consultation with the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following rules:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules may be cited as the Coroners (Salaries, Fees and Expenses) Amendment Rules (Northern Ireland) 1973 and shall have effect as from the 1st April 1973.

Payments to jurors

2. Rule 9 of the Coroners (Salaries, Fees and Expenses) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1971(b) shall be amended by substituting the amount “£1” for the words “sixty-eight pence” and “£3” for the amount of “£1·35”.
