To be laid before the Parliament of the United Kingdom under paragraph 4(5)(b) of the Schedule to the Northern Ireland (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972.

The Ministry of Development (in this Order referred to as "the Ministry") with the approval of the Ministry of Finance and on behalf of the Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 15 of the Housing (No. 2) Act (Northern Ireland) 1946(a) (in this Order referred to as "the No. 2 Act of 1946") and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Housing (Grants) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973 and shall come into operation on the 1st January 1974.

Contributions payable to persons in respect of houses built for letting

2. The contributions payable by a district council in respect of housing accommodation provided for workers in accordance with the provisions of section 1(1) of the Housing and Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland) 1946(b), (in this Order referred to as "the Act of 1946") and the sums payable by the Ministry under section 1(2) of the Act of 1946 to the district council in respect of those contributions shall, in relation to each new house completed between the 1st January 1974 and the 31st December 1974 inclusive, and falling within any one of the three categories mentioned in the first column of Schedule 1, consist respectively of a single payment of the amount specified opposite such category in the second and third columns of Schedule 1.

Grants payable to persons in respect of houses built for owner occupation

3. The grant payable by a district council under section 6(1) of the No. 2 Act of 1946, and the sum payable by the Ministry under section 6(2) to the district council in respect of this grant shall, in relation to each new house completed between the 1st January 1974 and the 31st December 1974 inclusive, and falling within any one of the three categories mentioned in the first column of Schedule 2, be respectively the amount specified opposite such category in the second and third columns of Schedule 2.
