MAGISTRATES' COURTS**Licensing (Amendment)**

RULES, DATED 29TH NOVEMBER 1973, MADE BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE UNDER SECTION 23 OF THE MAGISTRATES' COURTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1964.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 23 of the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(a), section 86 of the Licensing Act (Northern Ireland) 1971(b), section 1(1) of the Northern Ireland (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972(c) and of every other power enabling me in that behalf, on the recommendation of the Magistrates' Courts Rules Committee and after consultation with the Lord Chief Justice, I hereby make the following Rules:—

Citation

1. These Rules may be cited as the Magistrates' Courts (Licensing) (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1973.

Amendment of Principal Rules

2. After Rule 6 of the Magistrates' Courts (Licensing) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1971(d) there shall be inserted the following Rule—

“Production of licence granted by district council under Local Government Act (Northern Ireland) 1934

6A. Where application is made for the renewal of a licence—

(a) for a hotel or restaurant and either an application is to be made or an order is in force for the premises under section 45 of the Act; or

(b) for any place of entertainment,

any licence required for those premises by the district council under section 31 of the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland) 1934(e) shall be produced to the court.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Rules, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Rules provide that where application is made for the renewal of a hotel or restaurant liquor licence and an order is sought allowing the grant or continuance of the additional permitted hours under section 45 of the Licensing Act (Northern Ireland) 1971 for part of the premises in which musical or other entertainment is provided, or where application is made for the renewal of a licence for a place of entertainment, any licence required for the premises under section 31 of the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland) 1934 must be produced to the court.
