Stock Exchange

REGULATIONS, DATED 26TH MARCH 1973, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE UNDER SECTIONS 38, 39, 365 AND 366 OF THE COMPANIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1960.

The Ministry of Commerce on behalf of the Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 38(7)(b), 39(1)(b), 365(8)(b) and 366(1)(b) of the Companies Act (Northern Ireland) 1960(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Companies (Stock Exchange) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973.

Revocation

2. The Companies (Stock Exchange) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1965(b) are hereby revoked.

Prescription of Stock Exchange

3. The Stock Exchange shall be a prescribed stock exchange for the purposes of sections 38, 39, 365 and 366 of the Companies Act (Northern Ireland) 1960.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

All the Stock Exchanges in the British Isles have now been amalgamated into a single organisation called The Stock Exchange and these Regulations prescribe that organisation for the purposes of certain provisions of the Companies Act (Northern Ireland) 1960.
