## STOCK TRANSFER

## Recognition of Stock Exchange

ORDER, DATED 26th MARCH 1973, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE STOCK TRANSFER ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1963.

The Ministry of Finance on behalf of the Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 4 of the Stock Transfer Act (Northern Ireland) 1963(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order :—

*Interpretation*

1. In this Order “the Stock Exchange” means the organisation known as “The Stock Exchange” formed by the amalgamation of the stock exchanges formerly comprised in the Federation of Stock Exchanges in Great Britain and Ireland.

*Recognition of Stock Exchange*

2. The Stock Exchange is hereby declared to be a recognised stock exchange for the purposes of the Stock Transfer Act (Northern Ireland) 1963.

*Revocation*

3. The Stock Transfer (Recognition of Stock Exchanges) Order (Northern Ireland) 1966(b) is hereby revoked.

*Citation*

4. This Order may be cited as the Stock Transfer (Recognition of Stock Exchange) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973.
