In accordance with section 73(2) of that Act, they have made such provision in relation to tenancies current when this instrument takes effect as appears to them to be just having regard to the variation effected by the instrument.

In accordance with section 73(4) of that Act(2), a draft of this instrument has been laid before and approved by resolution of the Scottish Parliament.
