**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions  
for Disabled Persons) (Scotland) Regulations 2002**

*Made* - - - - 3rd October 2002  
*Laid before the Scottish  
Parliament* - - - - 4th October 2002  
*Coming into force* - - 8th November 2002

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 124 of, and paragraphs 21, 22(1)(d) and 25 of Part III of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as read with section 22 of the 1984 Act<sup>(1)</sup> and section 21(1)(b) of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970<sup>(2)</sup> and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with section 134(2) of the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Regulations:
