**The Kava-kava in Food (Scotland) Regulations 2002**

**Prohibition on sale etc. of food consisting of or containing Kava-kava**

3.—<sup>[F1]</sup>(1 ) Subject to paragraph (2),] no person shall—

- (a) sell;
- (b) possess for sale or offer, expose or advertise for sale; or
- (c) import into Scotland,

any food consisting of or containing Kava-kava.

<sup>[F2]</sup>(2) The prohibition imposed by paragraph (1) shall not apply where the food consisting of or containing Kava-kava is imported from a third country if the food is being, or is to be, exported to the same or a different third country.]
