Prohibition on sale etc. of food consisting of or containing Kava-kava

- 3.—[F1(1) Subject to paragraph (2),] no person shall—
 - (a) sell
 - (b) possess for sale or offer, expose or advertise for sale; or
 - (c) import into Scotland,

any food consisting of or containing Kava-kava.

[F2(2) The prohibition imposed by paragraph (1) shall not apply where the food consisting of or containing Kava-kava is imported from a third country if the food is being, or is to be, exported to the same or a different third country.]
