The Intercountry Adoption (Hague
Convention) (Scotland) Regulations 2003

PART 2

Procedure in Scotland where the United Kingdom is the receiving State

Application for assessment of suitability to be an adoptive parent

3.—(1) A person habitually resident in the British Islands who wishes to adopt a child habitually resident in a Convention country⁽¹⁾ outside the British Islands shall apply to an adoption agency for assessment of that person's suitability to be an adoptive parent.

(2) An application under this regulation shall be made in writing and shall include such information as the agency may require.
