The Road Works (Sharing of Costs of Works) (Scotland) Regulations 2003

Diversionsary works executed by an undertaker because of an authority's major works

3.—(1) Where, because of major works initiated by an authority, an undertaker executes diversionsary works, the authority shall pay to the undertaker—

- (a) where the major works are major transport works (other than major bridge works or section 145(3)(a) to (f) works) and payment is made in accordance with regulation 8(1), a sum equal to 92.5 per cent of the allowable costs of the diversionsary works;
 - (b) in other cases where payment is made in accordance with regulation 8(1), a sum equal to 82 per cent of the allowable costs of the diversionsary works;
 - (c) in all other cases, the allowable costs of the diversionsary works.
- (2) This regulation is subject to regulation 6.
