The Jam and Similar Products (Scotland) Regulations 2004

Transitional provisions

9. In any proceedings for an offence under these Regulations it shall be a defence for the person charged to prove that—

- (a) the food concerned was marked or labelled before 12th July 2004; and
- (b) the matters constituting the alleged offence would not have constituted an offence under the Jam and Similar Products (Scotland) Regulations 1981⁽¹⁾ if those Regulations had been in force when the food concerned was marked or labelled.
