**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING**

**The Town and Country Planning (Fees for Applications and Deemed Applications) (Scotland) Regulations 2004**

*Made* - - - - *13th May 2004*  
*Coming into force* - - *1st June 2004*

The Scottish Ministers in exercise of the powers conferred by section 252 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997(1), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations, a draft of which has, in accordance with subsection (4) of that section, been laid before and approved by resolution of the Scottish Parliament:
