The Agricultural Wages (Permits to Infirm and Incapacitated Persons) (Repeals) (Scotland) Regulations 2004

Citation, commencement and extent

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Wages (Permits to Infirm and Incapacitated Persons) (Repeals) (Scotland) Regulations 2004 and shall come into force on 1st October 2004.

(2) These Regulations extend to Scotland only.

Permits under section 5 of Agricultural Wages (Scotland) Act 1949

2.—(1) Section 5 of the Agricultural Wages (Scotland) Act 1949(1) is hereby repealed.

(2) Every permit granted or having effect as if granted under section 5 of the Agricultural Wages (Scotland) Act 1949 and which was in force immediately before 1st October 2004 shall cease to have effect from that date.

Repeals

3. The enactments specified in the first column of the Schedule to these Regulations are repealed to the extent specified in the third column of the Schedule.
